This is to notify the Huning Castle Neighborhood Association that on Sunday, May 24, the Albuquerque Family Advocacy Center (AFAC) will be holding a Career Moves 5k Run/Walk fundraising event.

The AFAC houses 15 different organizations including the Albuquerque Police Department Violent Crimes and Juvenile Sections to help both adult and child victims of interpersonal violence, domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault and rape. It has both government and non-profit service providers all under one roof to make it easier for victims to get access to the services they need to improve their lives.

The mission of the AFAC is to provide a facility where victims have access to comprehensive, multi-disciplinary services. The focus of the center is to decrease victim trauma and intimidation while providing supportive services in respectful and culturally appropriate ways. Each employee at the AFAC, whether sworn, civilian or volunteer, plays a vital role in upholding these ideals and meeting our overall vision.

The run starts at 8:00 am and the 2k walk starts at 8:15 am. The Albuquerque Police Department along with the APD Cadet Class will be assisting with traffic control along the run route in your neighborhood.

This event is open to the public and includes displays of police and fire equipment and entertainment at the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Silver Avenue SW.
